Students

Promotion/Acceleration/Retention

Promotion, acceleration, and retention of a student to a particular grade shall always be made in the best interest of the student.

Promotion, acceleration, and retention form grade in the elementary school shall be based on the following:

- 1. The achievement of the student is the present grade.
- 2. The ability of the child to do work in the succeeding grade.
- 3. Recommendations and information provided by the professional staff.
- 4. The expressed desires of the parent/guardian.
- 5. Other data relevant to the decision.

In addition to the above, successful completion of the published number of credits for promotion shall be considered for the promotion, acceleration, and retention of high school students. The Principal shall be responsible for making the final decision as to retention and assignment.
