

New Construction

Retirement of Buildings

A building operated and maintained by the school district may be retired from use when the Board of Education determines that it is no longer useful to the district and/or is unsuitable to the current needs or projected needs of the district. When a building is retired from use, it shall be returned to the Town and shall no longer be operated or maintained by the Board of Education.
