Bylaws of the Board

Election of Members

As required by law, members of the Board are elected at large by the Town electorate. Elections are part of the regular biennial elections held on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November.

Terms of office of all members of the Board of Education shall be four (4) years, and elections held biennially. At the 1995 biennial election, and at each four year interval thereafter, five members shall be elected; at the 1997 biennial election, and at each four year interval thereafter, four members shall be elected.

Terms of newly-elected Board members shall commence on the second Tuesday after said election.
